# **Elk Statue Vandalized**

Arlan Scholl looks over the antlerless elk statue in front of the Bismarck Elks Lodge. A culprit, or culprits, sawed the antlers off at the base and broke the spotlight that illuminated the statue sometime over the weekend (April 16th-18th, 2021), according to the Bismarck Police Department. The antlers are valued at \$2,000.

It's been 15 years or more since the elk was last vandalized. Scholl says it has happened about a dozen times since 1966 when the statue was erected. #14210
