

2022–2023 and 2023–2024 Membership Fee Update

From the Officers and Trustees, please know we do appreciate you and your membership to the Bismarck Mandan Elks Lodge 1199. Without you, this Lodge would not exist.

The Grand Lodge has informed all Elks Lodges across the country of a membership fee increase of \$5.00 each year for the next two years; 2022-23 and 2023-24. We don't have any say in those increases, but we as board must expedite this increase.

For some of you, this increase is minimal, and for some of you, the increase is substantial. What we as the Board of Trustees and Officers are proposing it to take the entire increase, \$10. 00 total in the 2022-2023 calendar year effective April 1 and raise the dues from \$96.00 to \$120.00. Yes, this is \$14.00 more than the increased established by the Grand Lodge, but due to COVID and inflation on food and beverages, the additional \$14.00 will help with the operating costs for the next year.

With every \$120.00 membership paid by April 15, members will receive a \$20.00 coupon which can be used in the TR Bar, or the Speak Easy Lounge. It's our intention to provide something of value, to you the members, to somewhat offset the fee increase. Lifetime member dues will increase to \$60.00.

The dues increase will be proposed at the next Lodge meeting on February 3 and voted on at the February 17 meeting. As a member, you are encouraged to attend the Lodge meetings and express your opinions and thoughts.




