# 2023 Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship Contest

The Elks National Foundation is proud to announce the start of the 2023 Elks Most Valuable Student scholarship contest!

The MVS Scholarship is available to high school seniors who are United States citizens. Applicants do not need to be related to a member of the Elks. The judging criteria is based on academics, leadership, service, and financial need.

The application is completed online and must be submitted by November 14, 2022. The 500 national winners will be announced in April 2023. The top 20 national finalists participate in the Leadership Weekend and interview for the top awards, ranging from \$20,000 to \$50,000. The remaining 480 runners-up receive \$4,000 scholarships.

The local Bismarck/Mandan Elks Lodge 1199 awards 6 scholarships at \$1,000 a piece to the top 3 boys and the

top 3 girls from our lodge applications.

The 2022 winners of these scholarships were Adam Gress, Chase Stockert, Warren Naslund, Sydney Ebach, Raegan Miller, and Cassidy Sommer! Congrats to all of them!!






