Congratulations to Lincoln Schoch as he moves on to the Elks National Hoop Shoot in Chicago, Illinois this April!!


Lincoln represents our Bismarck/Mandan Elks Lodge #1199, and he shot 24 out of 25 free throws to advance to the Nationals!!
