# Lincoln Schoch Honored for Placing Second at Elks National Hoop Shoot

Bismarck Mandan Elks Lodge #1199 recognized Lincoln Schoch at a welcome reception on Thursday, May 4, 2023 at the Elks Lodge. Lincoln placed second at the Elks National Hoop Shoot free throw competition on Saturday, April 22, 2023 at the Wintrust Arena in

Chicago, IL.

Lincoln is a third grader at St. Anne's elementary in Bismarck. Lincoln won the Bismarck Hoop Shoot contest in December in Bismarck, ND; took first at the State competition in January in Jamestown, ND; and placed first at the Regional competition in March in Rapid City, SD. He competed with eleven athletes ages 8-9



at the National competition. Each athlete must shoot 25 baskets. At Nationals in Chicago, Lincoln was challenged with three consecutive shoot outs vying for the second place win. Lincoln made 23 of 25 regular free throw baskets and 15 out of 15 shoot out free throws.

Lincoln's parents are Kristin and Brock Schoch of Bismarck. Lincoln's family had all of their expenses paid by the Elks on each leg of this competition.

The Elks Hoop shoot had approximately 200,000 national participants this year from the local level. In the 51 years of National Finals, there have been 88 North Dakota Finalists, and five national champions.

This is quite an accomplishment! Congratulations Lincoln!

If you have not paid your dues or perhaps did not receive a statement, please contact the office and we will be happy to help you out.




