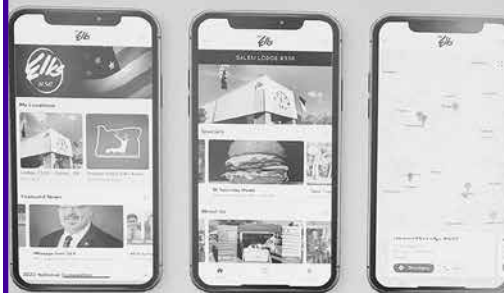

Over 3,000,000 boys and girls ages 8-13 participate nationally in the "Hoop Shoot" free throw contest. Locally 6 schools participated in preliminary contests. Out of the winners at the school level, 22 students

(13 girls and 9 boys) participated at the district contest held at Wachter Middle School. The first place winners advanced to the state Hoop Shoot, which was held Saturday, February 3rd, 2024 at the Jamestown High School in Jamestown ND. The regional contest was held in Rapid City SD on March 9, 2024 and the national finals were held on April 20, 2024 in Chicago, Illinois.
