Saturdays our famous Seafood Saturday from noon to 2pm in the TR Bar, followed by Trivia from 2 to 4pm.


It's winter again so check your calender: the annual Children's Christmas party will be held December 14th, from noon to 3pm. Bring the kids or grandkids to see Santa.


