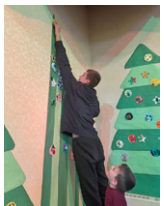
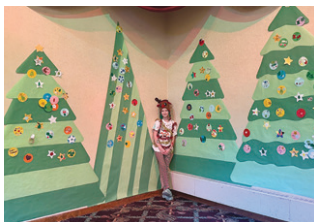
Raffle tickets are due in the Elks office on or prior to March 26th and the winners will be selected from the big bin on Thursday night, March 26th at 8pm.

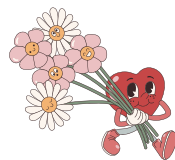

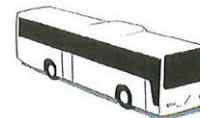
