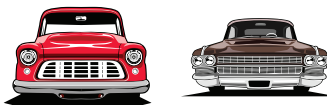

# Deadwood Bus Trip — April 2026

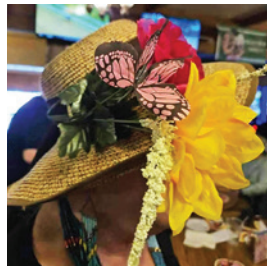
