Exalted Ruler Message — Josh Atkinson

My fellow Elks of Bismarck-Mandan #1199, Summers move quickly in North Dakota, and this one has not been an exception. We've already held great events, including the Bourbon & Bluegrass Night, the Roughrider Car show, and grilling out for

the McQuade's Softball Tournament. Thank you to all of the volunteers who have made these events possible. Esteemed Leading Knight Earl Hathaway has started a Challenge Coin for our Lodge, which is given to those that volunteer to help at events or have otherwise excelled in service to the Elks #1199. We'll get you added to the list of volunteers, and we'd love to have you!

On the 4th of July, I traveled to Chicago for the 161st National Elks Convention. Despite having to divert to Grand Rapids, Michigan for an hour due to a thunderstorm in the area, myself and PERs Mark Webster and Craig Boehm were able to make it in time for the St. Louis Cardinals vs. Chicago Cubs game that night. Unfortunately, we were not able to see many fireworks, as a thick fog rolled in off the lake and covered the city.

Opening Session on July 5th saw PER Rod Bakken carry the North Dakota flag in the opening procession as the new President of the North Dakota State Elks Association. Hospitality rooms opened that night, and I was able to visit with Elks from states all across the nation.

The General Session opened bright and early the morning of the 6th, where Timothy F. Yaeger was installed as the new Grand Exalted Ruler. In the afternoon, I attended seminars on the Elks National Foundation and Youth Activities. In the Youth Activities seminar, I learned that the Soccer Shoot Program is once again a recognized Grand Lodge Program. With the United States hosting matches of the World Cup, the Activities Committee believes that using the excitement generated from the World Cup can be a starting point for local Lodges to host a Soccer Shoot. If you would be interested in helping re-launch our Lodge Soccer Shoot program, please reach out to me.

July 7th General Session saw the passage of four resolution brought forth by the Judiciary Committee in regards to language

clarifications in the By-Laws. Surprisingly, there were no Lodge-initiated resolutions this year. In the afternoon, myself and several other North Dakota Elks visited the Elks National Memorial, which was celebrating it's 100th anniversary. This building also contains the headquarters of the Grand Lodge and the Elks National Foundation. There, along with the beautiful art and decorations, I saw the photos of the three Past Grand Exalted Rulers from North Dakota: Sam Stern of Fargo #260, Ray Dobson of Minot #1089, and Jack Traynor of Devils Lake # 1216. It was a truly special opportunity, and if you ever get the chance to visit I highly encourage it.

The North Dakota State Elks Association Annual Convention will be held July 31st-August 2nd at Dickinson Lodge #1137. Myself and several other Bismarck-Mandan Elks will be in attendance, and I will have my report for you in the next newsletter.

As the summer comes to a close, I hope to see you out on the patio for music on Tuesday and Wednesday nights, Thursday nights for 2-for-20 burger baskets in the TR Bar, Friday nights for the 11 O'clock Toast, or any other time our building is open. As always, thank you for being the Best People on Earth!

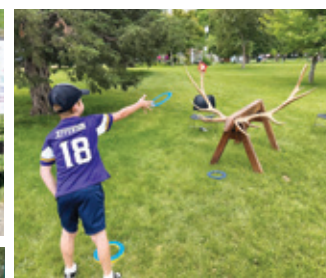
